

## **75öre – A Musical Journey Without Borders**

The Swedish duo 75öre, featuring Ivan Monthan and Hanna Stenlund Monthan, creates music that is as boundless as it is deeply heartfelt. Drawing influences from classical music, rock, folk, and world music, they craft a sound that is cinematic, narrative-driven, and profoundly moving. Their interplay has been described as "better than morphine", a musical journey where just two instruments resonate with the depth of a full orchestra.

Since their debut in 2003, 75öre has blurred the lines between genres and art forms, collaborating with theater, film, and circus productions. Notable milestones include composing music for The Royal Dramatic Theatre's adaptation of *Jane Eyre* (2014) and founding Teater MO (2015), a music theater company focused on productions for children and young audiences.

Now, 2025 marks a new chapter with the release of their upcoming album "Conversations", featuring entirely new compositions, as well as music created for Eldnatten at Urkult Festival. With a fearless and unrestricted approach to composition, 75öre creates a sonic world where everyone can find something to connect with—regardless of background or musical taste.

With cello and nyckelharpa at the core of their sound, 75öre invites listeners on a unique and deeply immersive musical journey, where every note tells a story.
